



Key sends 100 helpers to Haiti

THIRD-SECTOR travel management company Key Travel has helped send 100 aid workers to Haiti in the aftermath of the earthquake.

The company was quickly alerted when the crisis began and was then able to give its clients, such as Oxfam, a complete rundown on charity staff who were in or due to travel to Haiti.

A spokesman said: "Some clients are huge organisations so they don't know where everybody is, where they are due to travel and when.
